What Does a Web Developer Do?

- ⇒ A Web Developer designs, creates, and modifies Web sites.
- ⇒ A Web Developer needs to have computer programming skills, knowledge of design techniques, and problem solving skills.
- ⇒ A Web Developer can make between \$33,000 to \$94,000 annually.

What Kind Of Education Do I Need?

- ⇒ Most Web Developers obtain a bachelors degree (4 years of college) in Computer Science or a related field.
